As a Staff Member at Banting, besides teaching duties, we served on several Volunteer Committees to: replace the tennis courts, add the lighting and screening, replace the decking and railing on the bridge across Spring Creek, had the roadway built along the east side of the G.A. Wright Field, with the funds from the cafeteria, paved the entire east parking lot, and set up the digital sign in the café. We held a Fundraising Banquet at Banting after the Presbyterian Church burned down. I was the Building Coordinator for the construction of St. Paul's Church, Alliston. On many of these projects, members of my family also volunteered there time.

As Mayor of New Tecumseth 1997 - 2003, besides the duties as Mayor, I visited Good Samaritan, Riverwood and Simcoe Manor monthly. I attended many functions to bring greetings and congratulations. I was a Board Member and Chair of the Gibson Centre when it was officially opened, and for several years after. I was on the Hospital Board when the Hospital was renovated. I was on the Physicians Recruitment and Retention Committee, bringing in multiple Physicians to our area. As a result of the involvement above, I served and I'm still serving on several Committees:

- > Selection of Hospital Board Members after they all resigned.
- > Maternal Child Advisory Committee for the Birthing Unit
- > Veteran's and Senior's Villa of Alliston Board - Recording Secretary.
- > Chair of the Finance Council at St. Paul's Church (incl. Meals on Wheels)
- > Project Manager for major upgrades at our Church (incl. repairs and maintenance)
- > Eucharistic minister and reader at St. Paul's Church

I expect that each of you has accumulated many Volunteer hours on very worthwhile projects. I commend you for this generosity and hope and pray that you will continue for the betterment of the Community.
